Please note: The amount given here are subject to change at any time. The summary is based on three options. Option 1) Fast Track with enrollment for 12 hours (Fall and Spring each) and 6 hours (following summer), degree can be completed in one year. The cost with scholarship, would be \$22,659.10. Option 2) Enrollment for 9 hours (Fall and Spring each) and 3 hours (following summer), will cost \$17,851.57 for the first year. Option 3) Enrollment for 9 hours (Fall and Spring each) and no summer enrollment, will cost \$13,771.06 for the first year. \*Some degree programs require a one hour seminar which will be an additional \$534.17 with scholarship. \*The renewal of the scholarship for the second year is considered for those students who have received a GPA of 3.75 or above while maintaining a full academic load during the first year. If GPA is not 3.75 or above after the first year, scholarship will not be renewed.

**If you are an international applicant who requires a Form I-20 for your F-1 visa, please note that the I-20 request will be processed as soon as you have accepted the admissions offer and submitted all required documents.**

Please note, before enrolling in courses, all new graduate students must submit **official** proof of a completed Bachelor's degree. If we have not received a **completed academic record** for you, you will not be able to enroll in classes at this time.
