The program was attended by 4th semester students of all branches.

Objectives: The primary objectives of the program were:

- 1. To raise awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse.
- 2. To educate participants on the signs and symptoms of drug addiction.
- 3. To provide information on prevention strategies and coping mechanisms.
- 4. To connect participants with local resources and support networks for drug prevention and rehabilitation.

Awareness programs equip them with the knowledge to make informed decisions and resist peer pressure. ☐ Legal Ramifications: Many drugs are illegal, and involvement in drug-related activities can lead to serious legal consequences, including imprisonment. Understanding the legal implications can deter individuals from engaging in drug use or trafficking. ☐ Public Safety: Drug abuse often leads to impaired judgment and risky behaviors, which can endanger both the user and others. Addressing the issue helps to maintain public safety and reduce incidents like driving under the influence or violent crime. Support and Rehabilitation: Raising awareness about drug abuse also involves highlighting available resources for support and rehabilitation. This ensures that those struggling with addiction know where to seek help and can access the necessary services to recover.




