



- **Brief about event:** The knowledge of the proper use, disposal of sanitary pads, and its related side effects during menstruation is a vital aspect of a woman's well-being. Use of sanitary pads appropriately and replacing them on time are essential practices needed to maintain menstrual hygiene. Failure to do so may lead to detrimental consequences that could affect the health of women and make them susceptible to reproductive tract infections.

Key Discussion Activities:

- A cross-sectional study was conducted among 258 intermediate school girls in government school at Ramanagara village. A semi-structured, self-administered questionnaire was used to collect information on demographics, menstrual history, knowledge about menstruation, hygiene practices, and school absence during menstruation. The survey was conducted from 9 September 2022 to 25 September 2022.
- The policy should ensure all government, government-aided and residential schools provide adolescent students with free sanitary napkins and access to a vending and disposal mechanism, the Bench said. Schools should also be equipped with separate washrooms for girl students.
- Studies show period poverty has a ripple effect: girl students drop out of school, are pushed into child marriage, and are more like to experience domestic violence, infections, reproductive illnesses, malnourishment and poor mental health.

The "Self Hygine " provided students with a platform to know the uasage of sanitary pads and maintaine hygine by self. It was the interaction section and womens comfortable talk where they are allowed to talk without any shy and grabbing more information which they were lack of, with this we also distributed pads for each of them and giving the information about hygine. Schools should also be equipped with separate washrooms for girl students.
